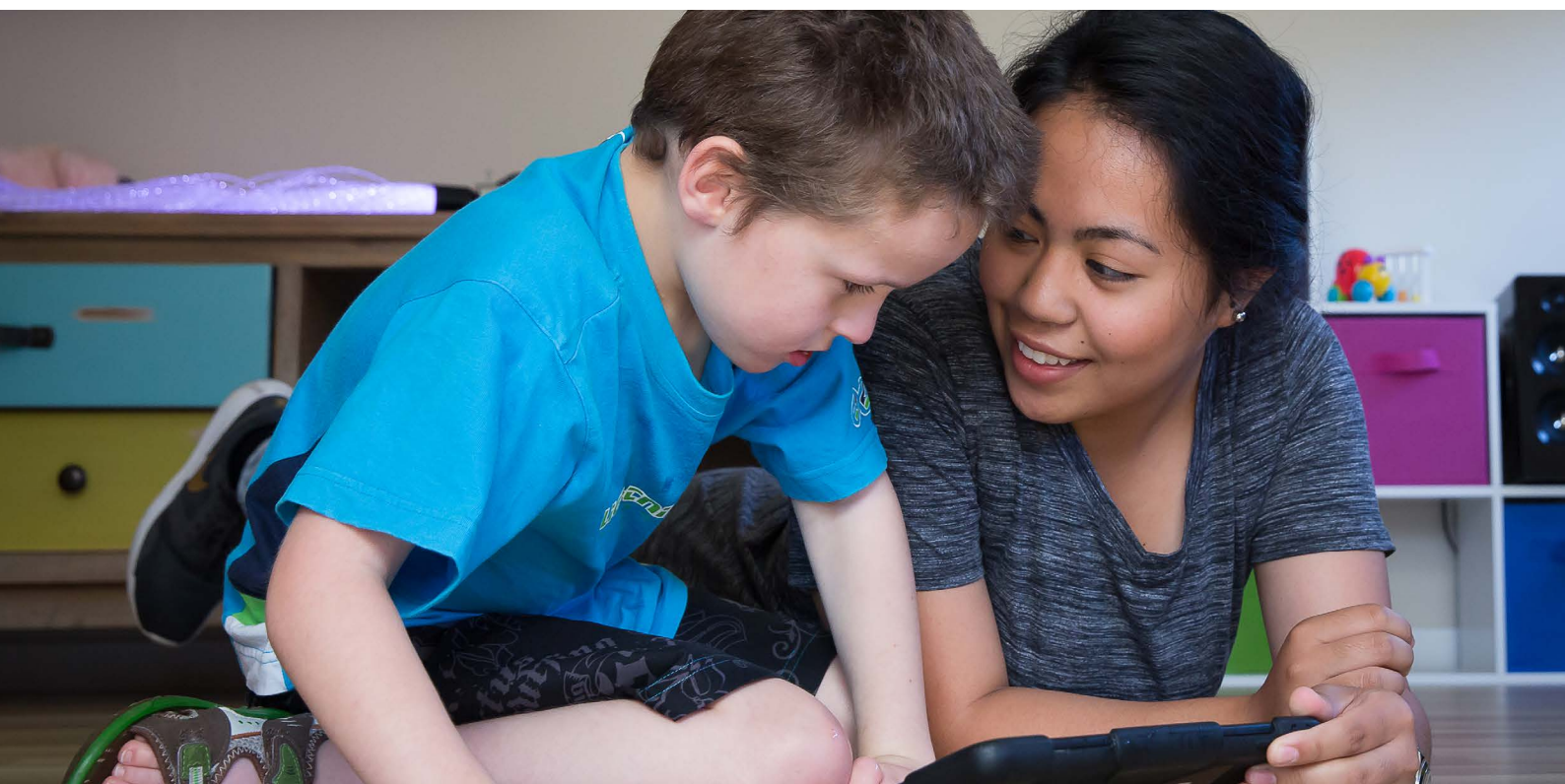


Children's Short Term Accommodation

Each participant has their own bedroom and they interact with their peers in shared areas and safe and secure outdoor play spaces. Cara's qualified, experienced and enthusiastic staff are always there.

In Short Term Accommodation, children and teens experience:

- Therapeutic play-based programs
